Scholarship Policy

Academic Scholarship (Only for Grade XI and XII students):

- 1. Students who excel in their Grade X Board exams are eligible for scholarships. This applies to students from any school, including DPS Bijnor, and from any recognized Board such as CBSE, ICSE, Cambridge, IB, etc.
- **2.** For students scoring 95% or above in Grade X, there's a Rs. 35,000 scholarship in Grade XI. If they maintain a cumulative result of 90% or above in Grade XI, they also get a Rs. 35,000 scholarship in Grade XII. The total scholarship for them is Rs. 70,000.
- **3.** For students scoring 90% or above in Grade X, there's a Rs. 17,500 scholarship in Grade XI. If they maintain a cumulative result of 85% or above in Grade XI, they also get a Rs. 17,500 scholarship in Grade XII. The total scholarship for them is Rs. 35,000.
- **4.** For calculating percentage in Grade X Board exams, marks of five main subjects will be calculated (and not best five). For Grade XI, marks of English, three stream subjects and best of 5th or 6th subject will be calculated.

Sports Scholarship (All Classes):

1. National Level Sports achievers will get 50% tuition fee waiver in the next one academic year.

Important Note:

- 1. The scholarship amount will be adjusted from the tuition fees for the last two quarters of each academic year. To apply, students need to submit a photocopy of required documents (mark sheets, certificates etc.) to the Accounts Department along with a scholarship application.
- **2.** A student will not be eligible for Academic Scholarship and Sports Scholarship, in the Academic Year, if:
 - (i) The student has been found guilty of gross misconduct and/or has been issued two or more Yellow Cards.
 - (ii) The student has been suspended from the school for any period of time.
 - (iii) The student is found guilty of being involved in any act of bringing disgrace to the school.
 - (iv) In case of any dues that are pending with the school accounts department, as per the school fee structure.
